<p>CREATIVITY/ORIGINALITY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Original idea or new twist on an old idea • Imaginative writing and/or script • Presents theme in an interesting, engaging way 	/5
<p>PRODUCTION QUALITY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Volume is consistent and background noise is minimal • Music or sound track is appealing and captures the mood of the scene • Visuals are effective and appealing (i.e. lighting & camera positioning are effective) 	/5
